The following is an attempt to transcribe the handwritten notes of the Organization of the Brotherhood Conference. Attached is a copy of the minutes.

A Committee confessed of elders T. Murphy, E.M. McVey, and A.J. Fannin, met with the Susanah Free Will Baptist Church to organize a Quarterly Meeting.

Called to order by T. Murphy, chairman.

On motion, A.A. Collins elected Clerk.

On motion, J.P. Hudson elected Treasurer.

On motion this Quarterly Meeting be called Brotherhood.

On motion the first Quarterly Meeting be held with the Christian Home Church, beginning on Friday before the first Sunday in May, 1911, at 2:00p.m.

Names of Churches composing this Quarterly Meeting, Susanah Free Will Baptist Church and the Christian Home Free will Baptist Church.

On motion A.A. Collins be messenger to Fayette Quarterly Meeting.

On motion I. M. Collins be messenger to Kanawha Quarterly Meeting. T. ?. Powers be alternate to Fayette, John Wyant alternate to Kanawha Quarterly Meeting.

On motion adjourn until Friday before the first Sunday in May, 1911.
