

NILE CHAPEL FREE WILL BAPTIST CHURCH

In 1960 a few dedicated Christians met regularly in the home of Arden and Elva Lockard, at Persinger, W.V. The attendance outgrew that home and was soon moved into a little barn. On November 4, 1962, an old one room school house was purchased. The Rev. T.C. Morgan officially named and dedicated the Nile Chapel Free Will Baptist Church, with Rev. Paris Brown as the first pastor.

Over the years, it has been remodeled by adding Sunday School Rooms, and a half basement.
